eCYBERMISSION MINI-GRANT PROGRAM



The eCYBERMISSION Mini-Grant program provides funding to support teachers as they implement eCYBERMISSION in their classrooms and schools. Applying is easy via our three-step, online application process. Teachers do not need to commit to participating as a Team Advisor or know exact student registration numbers to apply. The Mini-Grant program is open to everyone. However, Title 1 schools and those working with underserved students are given special consideration.

eCYBERMISSION is a free, online STEM competition for 6th to 9th graders.

Students form teams of 2-4, led by an adult Team Advisor, and select a problem in their community to explore with science or solve with engineering.

Any Team Advisor is encouraged to apply. Special consideration is given to:

- School/program location and Title 1 status
- Number of students planning to register
- Percentage of:
 - Racial/ethnic/gender minorities in STEM
 - Free and reduced lunch
 - English Language Learners

2023-2024 MINI-GRANT FUNDING

FUNDING STRUCTURE

- Grant value is based on the selection criteria and number of registered students
- First payment is issued to the school for project supplies and is based on the number of registered students on complete teams
- Second payment is issued directly to Team Advisors as a stipend and is based on the number of students who submitted Mission Folders

FUNDING BREAKDOWN

Grant Level	Criteria	First Payment	Second Payment
Level 1	0-199 Students Not Title 1 or <38% free/reduced lunch	\$7 / student	\$10 / student
Level 2	0-199 Students Title 1 or >38% free/reduced lunch	\$9 / student	\$14 / student
Level 3	200+ Students	\$10 / student	\$16 / student

Please note that Mini-Grant level is based on the school information and/or the school's total number of registered students on a complete team. Schools receiving a Level 2 Grant may qualify for an early dispersal of first payment funds.
