Leaded gasoline is now history. Yet from Flint, Michigan, to Dhaka, Bangladesh—and almost everywhere in between—the silent scourge lead poisoning is still with us.

In America, lead exposure persists in old paint and housing, on military bases, and, increasingly, from food and consumer goods imported from abroad. And around the world, an estimated 800 million children still have elevated blood lead levels, with the burden overwhelmingly concentrated in low- and middle-income countries. Children exposed to lead lose out on their full potential to learn and thrive; in adults, lead also causes neurological symptoms and increases long-term risk of cardiovascular disease.

On behalf of the Center for Global Development and our co-sponsor Pure Earth, we invite you to join us for a half-day of learning, sharing, and connecting about how we can collectively relegate lead poisoning to the history books. Through a series of panels, interactive learning stations, and plenty of opportunities to connect over drinks and nibbles, the event will celebrate successes in reducing the national and global burden of lead poisoning; highlight the changing face of lead poisoning beyond petrol, pipes, and paint; consider the surprising ways in which lead pollution abroad affects American families; and explore high-impact strategies for a future free of lead poisoning.
