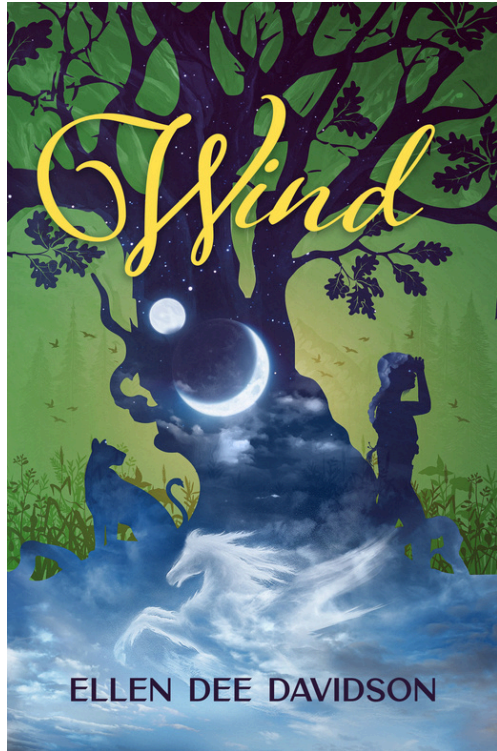


Wind
