Environmental Education Evaluation

- Have you begun a journey towards culturally relevant,
 responsive, and equitable environmental education programming and practices?
- Do you want to learn alongside those you serve to understand the value and impact of your initiatives and programs?
- Do you have a project in mind that would benefit from evaluation or new approaches to evaluation?

If you answered yes to all of these questions, you might be eligible for one of 25 slots in an upcoming guided environmental education evaluation (eeVAL) journey offered through the generous support of the Pisces Foundation.

We are thinking of environmental education broadly -- our network brings together practitioners, evaluators, and learners of all sorts who want to cultivate an evaluation practice leading to more just, inclusive, and healthy partnerships, programs, and communities

Guided eeVAL Journey

The series includes six 60-minute sessions (plus optional 30-minute post-session unstructured conversations) and suggested field applications between sessions. In addition, eeVAL will sponsor up to three 30-minute one-on-one consultations with an experienced culturally responsive evaluation guide for each participating organization to workshop their evaluation. Session topics include:

Authentic Engagement & Framing Evaluation Questions Equity & Evaluation Deep Curiosity & Information Gathering High-Quality Evaluation Storytelling and Reporting

Sessions are scheduled for October 2024 - June 2025. Members who attend 5 of 6 sessions will be eligible for a stipend paid at the end of the last session, \$350 per participant.

For organizations, multiple members (up to three) can participate in the series, but they must have a singular evaluation project/focus that they are collectively working to develop or implement. If you work in a public school setting, this learning journey would be most appropriate if you coordinate programming at larger scales, like across your district or between multiple schools or districts. Each organization will hold one seat for one-on-one coaching sessions

We will balance participation to include:

- a variety of affiliations and experiences
- who identify as organizations/communities/people with identities that have been historically and presently pushed to the margins
- scale of organizations/programming from (single owner/consultants to larger organizations)
- many approaches to connecting people and communities to the environment.
